## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATING TO DEDUCTIONS FROM SALARY FOR CREDIT UNIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 178B of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 458 of the acts of 1966, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting  
4 in place therefor the following sentence:— The state treasurer,  
5 the treasurer of any county, or state department or institution,  
6 and the treasurer of any city or town having a by-law or or-  
7 dinance so requiring shall, and unless contrary to a by-law or  
8 ordinance the treasurer of any other city or town or of any  
9 district may deduct from the salary of any employee of the  
10 Commonwealth or of any such county, city, town or district  
11 such amount or amounts as such employee in a written au-  
12 thorization to such treasurer may specify for purchasing shares  
13 of, or making deposits in, or repaying any loan from any credit  
14 union operated by employees of the commonwealth, of any such  
15 county, city, town or district or members of the Massachusetts  
16 teachers association.
