AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE ASSISTANT TO THE COMMISSIONER OF AGRICULTURE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 20 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out said section 5 and inserting the
3 following section:—

4 *Section 5.* The assistant commissioner shall receive such
5 salary not exceeding fourteen thousand dollars, as the gov-
6 ernor and council may determine, and traveling expenses
7 incurred in the performance of his official duties and shall
8 devote his full time during business hours to the duties of his
9 office.
