AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE COMMISSIONER, ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER AND ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 23 of the General Laws as amended by
2 chapter 844 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the second sentence, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following new sentence:—The commissioner shall
5 receive such salary not exceeding twenty thousand dollars,
6 and the assistant commissioner and the associate commis-
7 sioners such salary not exceeding twelve thousand five hun-
8 dred dollars, as the governor and counsel may determine, and
9 each shall devote his full time during business hours to the
10 duties of his office.
