By Mr. LaFontaine of Gardner, petition of the Service Employees International Union, AFL-CIO, CLC, and Raymond M. LaFontaine for legislation to provide for differential payments for certain state employees required to work evenings, nights and on weekends. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DIFFERENTIAL PAY FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES REQUIRED TO WORK EVENING, NIGHT AND WEEKEND TOURS OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, the
2 director of personnel and standardization shall be authorized
3 to negotiate with employee organizations for differential pay
4 for night, evening and weekend tours of duty for employee
5 groups they are certified to represent not to exceed twelve per
6 cent above regular compensation and to establish rules for
7 payment for such differential. A copy of any agreements
8 negotiated under the provisions of this section shall be filed
9 with the state treasurer, the state auditor and the secretary of
10 state.
