AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ORDERLY AND EXPEDITIOUS HANDLING OF APPEALS IN PERSONNEL MATTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing, in section 53, after the word "appeal" in line 16, the follow-
3 ing words: — within ninety days. Said chapter is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the above phrase, the following
5 words: — and any appeal now pending, or pending on the effec-
6 tive date of this act, shall also be heard and adjudicated within
7 the same ninety days after the signing of said act.
