### AN ACT TO CORRECT THE ALPHABETICAL ORDER OF CERTAIN DEFINITIONS IN THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 In order that the definitions appearing in section one of chap-  
2 ter thirty-one of the General Laws may continue to appear in  
3 alphabetical order, the definitions inserted by chapter seven  
4 hundred and eighty of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-  
5 seven and chapter six hundred and fifty-two of the acts of nine-  
6 teen hundred and sixty-eight, respectively, and the definition  
7 for "Competitive promotional examination" are hereby re-  
8 arranged so that they appear after the definition for "Competi-  
9 tive examination", in the following order:— "Competitive  
10 promotional examination", "Continuous examination", "De-  
11 partment", and "Departmental promotional examination".
