AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ONE ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 62, as most recently amended by chapter
3 764 of the acts of 1968, and inserting in place thereof the fol-
4 lowing section:—

5 *Section 62.* In the municipal court of the city of Boston
6 the court officers appointed shall not exceed ten for criminal
7 business, one of whom shall be designated by the chief justice
8 as chief court officer of said court for criminal business and
9 one as an assistant chief court officer, nor five for civil busi-
10 ness, one of whom shall be designated by said chief justice as
11 chief court officer of said court for civil business; in the muni-
12 cipal court of the Roxbury district eight court officers may be
13 appointed; in the municipal court of the Dorchester district
14 seven court officers may be appointed, of whom one shall be
15 designated by the justice of said court as chief court officer and
16 one assistant chief court officer; in the third district court of
17 eastern Middlesex and in the central district of Worcester five
18 court officers may be appointed; in the district court of Spring-
19 field four court officers may be appointed; in the municipal
20 court of the West Roxbury district, in the district court of
21 Somerville, in the district court of East Norfolk, in the East
22 Boston district court, and in the fourth district court of east-
23 ern Middlesex three court officers may be appointed; in the
24 third district court of Bristol, in the municipal court of the

25 South Boston district, of the Charlestown district, the district
26 court of Chelsea, the first district court of eastern Middlesex,
27 the second district court of eastern Middlesex, the district court
28 of Newton, the district court of northern Norfolk and the
29 second district court of Plymouth two court officers for each
30 court may be appointed; and in each of the other district courts
31 in the commonwealth one court officer may be appointed.
