AN ACT TO REGULATE BARBERS AND BARBER SHOPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 87H of chapter 112 of the General Laws is
2 amended by adding the following 2 paragraphs at the end
3 thereof:—

4 The board shall not renew nor grant a certificate of
5 registration to any person to own and operate a barber shop
6 unless said person is a registered barber or the widow of a
7 registered barber.

8 Every registered barber shall annually file with the board
9 of registration of barbers his place of employment as a
10 barber. Failure to file shall be cause for loss of license.
