AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHARTER SCHOOL OR SPECIAL SERVICE BUSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 11A of chapter 159A of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in chapter 537 of the acts of
3 1965, is hereby amended by striking out the third sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—The
5 terms “charter service”, “special service” or “school service”
6 shall not include the transportation of school children to and
7 from school pursuant to a written contract with a municipi-
8 pality or municipal board or with the authorities of such
9 school, provided that the charges for such transportation are
10 borne by such municipality or municipal board or school; and
11 provided, further, that no special charges for such transporta-
12 tion are made by the municipality or municipal board on
13 account of the children transported; or the operation of a
14 motor vehicle so used and owned and operated by such
15 authorities; or the operation of sight-seeing automobiles
16 licensed under chapter three hundred and ninety-nine of
17 the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-one.
