AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO PLACE ITS EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NUMBER ON ITS POLICE VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
