AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THE CLERK OF COURTS, AND THE REGISTER OF PROBATE OF BRISTOL COUNTY TO CONSTRUCT THE NEW BUILDING FOR THE COURTS AND VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS OF SAID COUNTY AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 393, ACTS OF 1966.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 393 of the acts of 1966 is hereby
2 amended by striking the words "county commissioners" and
3 "commissioners" as appearing in the first, third and fourth
4 sentences of section 1 of said act and the first, third, fourth
5 and sixth sentences of section 2 of said act, and substituting
6 therefor the words: — Chairman of the board of county com-
7 missioners, clerk of courts, and register of probate, or a ma-
8 jority of them.

1 SECTION 2. The fourth sentence of section 1 of said act
2 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word "speci-
3 fications" a comma and the words: — site survey/location
4 planning fees, test borings, appraisal fees, eminent domain
5 acquisition fees, lease fees, purchase fees, option fees, and
6 attorney fees.

1 SECTION 3. Section 3 of said act is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the words "Upon the completion of the build-
3 ing as provided for in section one," the words: — it shall be
4 transferred to the county commissioners of Bristol County
5 who shall own and administer same, and
