## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT REGISTRATION SESSIONS IN WARDS NEED NOT  
BE HELD PRIOR TO CITY ELECTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 29B of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 2 of chapter 236 of the acts of  
3 1966, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sen-  
4 tence and inserting in place thereof the following two sen-  
5 tences:—In cities the registrars shall, within sixty days before  
6 the biennial state election, on or before the last day fixed for  
7 registration, hold one or more sessions in one or more suitable  
8 places in each ward of the city. They shall, within sixty days  
9 before the regular city election, but on or before the last day  
10 fixed for registration, hold such sessions unless the city coun-  
11 cil votes otherwise.
