### AN ACT RELATIVE TO TIRES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 adding after section 7K the following section:—  
3 *Section 7L.* No person shall sell, offer or expose for sale,  
4 have in his possession with intent to sell, or give away for use  
5 on any motor vehicle, motorcycle, or trailer any tire which is  
6 a second, retread, or recap unless such tire has a plainly  
7 visible identifying mark on the tire. These marks shall be in  
8 raised one-inch red letters and marked thus: R for recaps or  
9 retreads; S for seconds.  
10 Whoever violates any provisions of this section shall be  
11 punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
