AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as amended by
2 chapter 844 of the acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence:— He shall serve for a term coterminous
5 with that of the governor and shall receive a salary not exceed-
6 ing twenty-five thousand dollars.

- 1 Section 17 of chapter 10 of the General Laws is amended by
- 2 chapter 387 of the acts of 1907, to read: "Chapter 387 of the
- 3 acts of 1907 shall not apply to the District of Columbia, but
- 4 shall apply to the District of Columbia in the same manner
- 5 with that of the Government and shall receive a salary not exceeding
- 6 the salary of the District of Columbia."
