*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end of paragraph 7 the following  
3 sentence:—Notwithstanding the above however, the step  
4 rate increases of each employee promoted under the provi-  
5 sions of this section shall continue from the original date  
6 of entry into the service of the commonwealth.
