## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING SUITABLE RECOGNITION TO CERTAIN VETERANS OF THE VIETNAM CONFLICT WHO CHOOSE TO REMAIN IN THE MILITARY SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 646 of the acts of 1968 is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 1, the following section:—
- 3 *Section 1A.* The provisions of this act shall apply to any
- 4 person who otherwise qualifies for payment under the preced-
- 5 ing section, but whose active military service has not yet been
- 6 terminated, and who proves to the satisfaction of the trea-
- 7 surer that he intends to remain in the military service, on
- 8 active duty, indefinitely.
