AN ACT REQUIRING THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO
AWARD CONTRACTS TO THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND ELIGIBLE
BIDDER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The second paragraph of chapter 598 of the acts of 1958
2 is hereby amended by striking out said paragraph and in-
3 serting in place thereof the following paragraph:—
4 Sections twenty-six to twenty-nine, inclusive, and sections
5 forty-four A to forty-four L, inclusive, of chapter one hun-
6 dred forty-nine of the General Laws and sections thirty-nine
7 F to thirty-nine M, inclusive, of chapter thirty of the Gen-
8 eral Laws shall apply to contracts of the authority to the
9 same extent and in the same manner as they are applicable
10 to the commonwealth. All general or special laws, or parts
11 thereof, inconsistent herewith, are hereby declared to be in-
12 applicable to the provisions of this act.
