AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORFOLK COUNTY TO INSTALL AN ELEVATOR IN THE NORFOLK COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT HOUSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Norfolk county  
2 are hereby authorized to install an elevator in the Norfolk  
3 county Superior Court House in the town of Dedham. Said  
4 commissioners may remodel, alter or make such additions to  
5 said court house as may be necessary for such installation.
