By Mr. Craven of Boston, petition of James J. Craven, Jr., that the Trustees of State Colleges be authorized to establish the salaries of officers and members of the professional staff of said colleges. Education.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE STATE COLLEGES TO ESTABLISH SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSIONAL STAFF OF THE STATE COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 16 of chapter 73 of the General Court is
2 hereby amended by striking out the paragraph beginning
3 "The Trustees shall elect the director . . ." and inserting in
4 place thereof the following new paragraph:—

5 The Trustees shall elect the director of the division of state
6 colleges, who shall be the administrative and executive secre-
7 tary of the board of trustees, and the presidents and such
8 other officers and members of the professional staff of each
9 state college as they may determine necessary. The trustees
10 may establish the salary for the director of the division of
11 state colleges and for the presidents without reference to the
12 general salary schedule and salary range. For other officers
13 and members of the professional staff the trustees shall fix
14 their classification, title and salary within the general salary
15 schedule, except that any such salary shall be fixed at not less
16 than the minimum nor more than the maximum salary shown
17 in such schedule; provided, however, that the trustees may
18 establish the salary for academic deans and members of the
19 professional teaching staff without reference to the general
20 salary schedule and range; and further provided that no such

21 salary shall be established for any academic dean or any
 22 member of the professional teaching staff unless his classifica-
 23 tion rating is equal to or higher than that of professor, nor
 24 shall the total member of such academic deans and members
 25 of the professional teaching staff whose salaries may be so
 26 established exceed one per cent of the total number of
 27 academic deans and members of the professional teaching
 28 staff together in the state college system.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph 2 of section 16 of said chapter 73 is
 2 hereby amended by the addition of the words: with the
 3 exceptions as herein before provided, at the end of the second
 4 sentence.
