RESOLVE THAT A STUDY COMMISSION BE ESTABLISHED TO INVESTIGATE THE CREATION OF NEIGHBORHOOD SCHOOLS RUN BY PARENTS.

1 *Resolved*, The department of education is hereby autho-
2 rized and directed to investigate and study the cost and
3 administration procedure necessary in order to build and
4 operate public high schools in designated low-income areas
5 whose operation shall be controlled by the parents of the
6 neighborhood, and the feasibility of creating neighborhood
7 school committees as permanent bodies, elected from among
8 the residents of the neighborhood, who shall share with the
9 town or city school committee the creation of educational
10 policy for their neighborhood, and the possibility of combin-
11 ing with such neighborhood school programs, job-training,
12 parent education in the skills necessary in parenthood and
13 job interview training and interview facilities, and the feasi-
14 bility of curriculum planning on the local level in cooperation
15 with the colleges and professional schools of the common-
16 wealth.

17 The commission herein created shall report its findings,
18 together with legislation recommended, if any, to the general
19 court by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or
20 before the first Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred
21 and sixty-nine.
