AN ACT AUTHORIZING CHIROPRACTIC CARE UNDER SERVICE CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The definition of "Participating physician" in
2 section 1 of chapter 176B of the General Laws, as appearing
3 in chapter 306 of the acts of 1941 is hereby amended by
4 inserting in line 1 after the word "physician" the words:—or
5 a chiropractor registered under the provisions of chapter one
6 hundred and twelve.

1 SECTION 2. The definition of "Associated physician" in
2 section 1 of chapter 176C of the General Laws, as appearing
3 in chapter 334 of the acts of 1941, is hereby amended by
4 inserting in line 4, after the word "health", the words:—or
5 any chiropractor registered under the provisions of chapter
6 one hundred and twelve.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT APPROVED JULY 1, 1906, RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION OF PHYSICIANS.

Enacted July 1, 1906.

SECTION 1. The definition of "physician" in section 1 of chapter 1701 of the Revised Laws of 1906, as amended by section 2 of the Act approved July 1, 1906, shall be amended by inserting in line 4 after the word "physician" the words "or a person registered under the provisions of chapter 1702 of the Revised Laws of 1906, as amended."

SECTION 2. The definition of "physician" in section 1 of chapter 1701 of the Revised Laws of 1906, as amended by section 2 of the Act approved July 1, 1906, shall be amended by inserting in line 4 after the word "physician" the words "or a person registered under the provisions of chapter 1702 of the Revised Laws of 1906, as amended."
