## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT GRANTING STATE EMPLOYEES ELECTED TO PUBLIC OFFICE  
CREDIT FOR SALARY INCREMENTS DURING LEAVE OF ABSENCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Paragraph (2) of section 46 of chapter 30 of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 65 of chapter 757  
3 of the acts of 1962, is hereby further amended by adding at  
4 the end the following sentence:—Notwithstanding the con-  
5 trary provisions of any rule or law, the service of an employee  
6 of the commonwealth, who has been elected to public office in  
7 the commonwealth and who is on leave of absence while per-  
8 forming the duties of such elected office, shall be considered as  
9 source for salary increments in the job group from which he  
10 received a leave of absence.
