AN ACT CONDITIONING CAPITAL COMMITMENTS BY THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ON APPROVAL BY THE ADVISORY BOARD TO IT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after clause (e) the following clause:—
- 3 (e¹/₂) No capital commitment shall be made unless sub-
- 4 mitted to the advisory board and approved by it.
