By Mrs. Gannett of Wayland and Mr. Harrington of Salem, petition of Ann C. Gannett and Michael J. Harrington for legislation to prohibit the overhead transmission of high voltage electricity within a radius of thirty miles from the State House. Government Regulations.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE TRANSMISSION OF HIGH VOLTAGE ELECTRICITY WITHIN A RADIUS OF THIRTY MILES FROM THE STATE HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 166 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 25 the following section:—
3 *Section 25A.* Notwithstanding the provisions of any gen-
4 eral or special law to the contrary, no overhead transmission
5 facility carrying a voltage in excess of thirteen and eight-
6 tenths kilovolts shall be constructed within a radius of thirty
7 miles from the state house in Boston.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section twenty-five A of
2 chapter one hundred and sixty-six of the General Laws,
3 inserted by section one of this act, shall not apply to overhead
4 electric transmission facilities under construction on the effec-
5 tive date of said act.
