AN ACT RELATIVE TO INVESTIGATING CERTAIN BUSINESS METHODS OR POLICIES OF THE EMPLOYER'S LIABILITY ASSURANCE CORPORATION, LIMITED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of insurance and the district attorney of
2 Suffolk county, acting as a joint board, are hereby authorized
3 and directed to make an investigation and study relative to
4 the taking, or attempted taking, of the property situated at
5 three Somerset street, Boston, Massachusetts by the Em-
6 ployer's Liability Assurance Corporation, Limited, to de-
7 termine if the said taking, or attempted taking, is an improper
8 or unsound business method or policy necessitating action by
9 the insurance commissioner under the provisions set forth in
10 section five of chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the
11 General Laws.
