AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CITY OF BOSTON BUILDING CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 665 of the acts of 1956 is hereby amended as follows:— All interested parties to any variance granted by the board of appeal shall be notified at least five days in writing prior to either party reapplying to the board after a public hearing has been held as otherwise provided in this act.
