AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE DEATH BENEFIT PAYABLE UNDER THE STATE-BOSTON RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO THE WIDOW OF CHARLES A. MCNABB WHO DIED OF INJURIES SUSTAINED IN LINE OF DUTY AS A POLICE OFFICER OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public good,
2 the accidental death benefit allowance payable under section
3 nine of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws to the widow
4 of Charles A. McNabb, who died on November twenty-third,
5 nineteen hundred and sixty-eight, as a result of injuries
6 sustained when shot on said date while in the performance of
7 his duty as a police officer of the city of Boston shall, subject
8 to the provisions and limitations of said section nine, consist
9 of a yearly amount of pension equal to the annual rate of
10 regular compensation which would have been payable to said
11 Charles A. McNabb had he continued in service as a police
12 officer of said city at the grade held by him at the time of his
13 death.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Boston.
