AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ESTABLISH A SYSTEM FOR THE PROMPT IDENTIFICATION OF STOLEN MOTOR VEHICLES IN ORDER TO PREVENT THEIR RE-REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The registrar of motor vehicles is hereby authorized and
2 directed to establish and maintain a system for prompt
3 identification of any motor vehicles which are known to be
4 stolen in order to prevent the re-registration of such vehicles.
5 For this purpose, the registrar is authorized to purchase or
6 rent computers or other devices which will facilitate the
7 prompt identification of such vehicles.
