By Mr. Curtiss of Sheffield, petition of James N. Rollins for legislation to establish the salary group classification for the position of State House postmaster and assistant State House postmaster. Public Service.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING JOB GROUP SEVENTEEN IN THE SALARY AND WAGE CLASSIFICATION PLAN TO BE THE JOB GROUP FOR THE POSITION OF STATE HOUSE POSTMASTER AND ESTABLISHING JOB GROUP FOURTEEN IN THE SALARY AND WAGE CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT STATE HOUSE POSTMASTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The salary and wage classification plan of section 6 chapter
- 2 30 of the General Laws shall be amended so that the position
- 3 of state house postmaster, account 044-01 shall be in Job
- 4 Group 17 of said plan and so that the position of assistant
- 5 state house postmaster, account 044-01 shall be in Job Group
- 6 14 of said plan.

The bill is of great importance to the people of this State, and it is the duty of the Legislature to take prompt action thereon. It is the policy of this State to encourage the development of the oil and gas resources of the State, and to provide for the conservation of these resources for the benefit of the people of this State.
