AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN INMATES FOR DAY WORK OUTSIDE THE STATE PRISON AND THE MASSACHUSETTS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION, CONCORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 86D of chapter 127 of the General Laws as inserted
2 by chapter 723 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the following words: — “section thirteen, fifteen
4 A, fifteen B, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-
5 six,” as listed on lines 5 through 8, and “seventeen”, as listed
6 on line 9.
