AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ARMORY COMMISSION TO TRANSFER THE COMMONWEALTH ARMORY IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO THE BOSTON SCHOOL DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The armory commission is hereby authorized and directed
2 to transfer the commonwealth armory in the city of Boston
3 to the Boston school department, and to grant the armory
4 commission a sum not to exceed eight million dollars for the
5 erection of eight armories at locations selected by the armory
6 commission.
