AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN CERTAIN RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE BRIGHTON SECTION OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct, care for and maintain on land,
3 commonly known as the Charles River Reservation, on
4 Soldiers' Field road in the Brighton section of the city of
5 Boston, an all purpose recreation building including therein,
6 basketball courts, indoor tennis courts and facilities for all
7 other indoor sports.

 John N. Alden, Edward A. Kelly and Norman E. Winchell of the
 Metropolitan Parks Commission be directed to construct certain recreational
