

HOUSE No. 2661

By Mr. Harrison of Gloucester, petition of the Association of Massachusetts Homes for the Aging for legislation to provide that the law establishing a minimum hourly rate for hours worked in excess of forty hours in a week shall not apply to employees in charitable homes for the aged. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE LAW ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM RATE FOR HOURS WORKED IN EXCESS OF FORTY HOURS IN A WORK WEEK SHALL NOT APPLY TO EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED IN CHARITABLE HOMES FOR THE AGED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The second paragraph of section 1A of chapter 151 of the
- 2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (16),
- 3 as appearing in chapter 431 of the acts of 1961, and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following clause:—
- 5 (16) in a hospital, sanatorium, convalescent or nursing
- 6 home, infirmary, rest home or charitable home for the aged.
