AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEARCH WARRANTS FOR PROPERTY OR ARTICLES
HAVING EVIDENTIAL VALUE ONLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 section 1 of chapter 557 of the acts of 1964, is hereby amended
- 3 by inserting after clause Fourth the following clause: —
- 4 Fifth, property or articles which there is probable cause to
- 5 believe will aid in apprehending or convicting the perpetrator
- 6 of a crime even though having evidential value only.
