AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE TO THE FALMOUTH LODGE NUMBER 2380, BENEVOLENT AND PROTECTIVE ORDER OF ELKS OF THE UNITED STATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of licenses
2 under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one
3 hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but subject,
4 however, to all other provisions of said chapter, including the
5 provisions of section sixteen C thereof, the licensing board of
6 the town of Falmouth is hereby authorized to issue to the Fal-
7 mouth Lodge Number 2380 Benevolent and Protective Order
8 of Elks of the United States an annual license to sell all
9 alcoholic beverages, to be drunk on its premises, to members
10 and to guests introduced by such members and to no others.
