AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF A COURT HOUSE IN THE TOWN OF WESTBOROUGH FOR THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN WORCESTER AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY THEREFOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a board consisting
2 of the chief of police, town counsel, and town moderator, of
3 the town of Westborough, the district attorney for the middle
4 district, or his designee, and the chairman of the county com-
5 missioners of Worcester county. Said board shall advise the
6 county commissioners on the location, construction and equip-
7 ping of a court house to provide suitable and adequate facil-
8 ities for the first district court of eastern Worcester at an
9 appropriate location in the town of Westborough, said county
10 commissioners, after consultation with and with the consent
11 of the board established hereunder, are hereby authorized to
12 construct and originally equip such court house. Said commis-
13 sioners may take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-
14 nine of the General Laws, or acquire by purchase or other-
15 wise, any land that may be necessary for the purposes of this
16 act, including a sufficient area for the parking of the motor
17 vehicles of persons in attendance upon said court. Said com-
18 missioners may expend for the purposes of this act, including

19 the preparation of plans and specifications in connection
20 therewith and for landscaping, such sums as may be necessary,
21 not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million dollars. Any
22 sums received from the federal government for the purposes
23 of this act shall be included in, and considered a part of, the
24 total amount authorized to be expended hereunder.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one,
2 the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county
3 commissioners, may borrow upon the credit of the county such
4 sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one
5 million dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county
6 therefor, which shall bear on their face the words, First Dis-
7 trict Court of Eastern Worcester Loan, Act of 1969. Each
8 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and such
9 loans shall be payable not more than twenty years from their
10 dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treas-
11 urer and countersigned by a majority of the county commis-
12 sioners. The county may sell the said securities at public or
13 private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county
14 commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their
15 par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as
16 herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the Gen-
17 eral Laws.

1 SECTION 3. The county treasurer of said county, with the
2 approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary
3 notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from
4 their dates, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds or notes
5 under this act, but the time within which such serial bonds or
6 notes shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of
7 such temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed by
8 this act. Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds
9 or notes shall be paid from the proceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
