AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS
AT COMMUNITY COLLEGES BY THE BOARD OF REGIONAL COMMUNITY
COLLEGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 15 of the General Laws is hereby amended at the
2 end by adding the following paragraph:—

3 The board of regional community colleges is hereby author-
4 ized and directed to grant certain scholarships annually in
5 number equal to two per cent of the September full time day
6 student enrollment of the preceding year to worthy students
7 who are residents of the commonwealth and who possess the
8 requisite ability and who are in need of financial assistance.
