AN ACT PERMITTING THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF ANY TOWN WHICH ACTS AS THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON LIQUOR LICENSES WHICH IT IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 10A the following section:—
3 *Section 10B.* The board of selectmen of any town in the
4 commonwealth which acts as the local licensing authority may
5 place such restrictions as it deems desirable on any license which
6 it is authorized to issue under this chapter.
