

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 3032

By Mr. McGlennon of Concord, petition of John A. S. McGlennon that the town of Acton be authorized to appropriate money for the annual observance of the anniversary of the participation by citizens of said town in the Battle of Concord. Local Affairs.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ACTON TO APPROPRIATE MONEY ANNUALLY IN ANTICIPATION OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE TWO HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE PARTICIPATION OF CITIZENS OF ACTON IN THE BATTLE OF CONCORD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Acton may appropriate money an-  
2 nually, from and including the year nineteen hundred and sixty-  
3 nine to and including the year nineteen hundred and seventy-  
4 five, for the celebration of the two hundredth anniversary of  
5 the battle between citizens of said town and British troops.

1 SECTION 2. Said town may establish in the town treasury a  
2 special fund in which shall be deposited such sums as may be  
3 appropriated by it under the provisions of this act. Any and  
4 all such sums received by the town treasurer shall be kept  
5 separate from any other moneys, funds or property of said town,  
6 and the principal and interest thereof may be expended for the  
7 purposes of this act by said town upon the authorization of its  
8 board of selectmen from time to time. Any surplus remaining  
9 in said special fund after such celebration is concluded shall be  
10 transferred by said treasurer into the treasury of said town.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
