AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF ESSEX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended in *Class I* by striking out the line
3 reading "second district court of Essex" and in *Class III*, as
4 most recently amended by chapter 273 of the acts of 1968,
5 by inserting after the line reading "the second district court
6 of Barnstable", the following line:—second district court of
7 Essex.
