AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL AND STANDARDIZATION TO PLACE THE POSITION OF SECRETARY OF THE BOARD OF MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES AND BONDS IN JOB GROUP XX IN THE GENERAL SALARY SCHEDULE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The Constitution of Massachusetts

As Amended to the Year 1890

1. The Governor of the Commonwealth shall hold office for a term of four years, and shall be eligible for re-election to the same office for one term only.
