AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO CONTRIBUTE A CERTAIN SUM TO THE CITY OF CHELSEA AS REIMBURSEMENT FOR LOSS OF TAX REVENUE AS A RESULT OF LAND TAKINGS BY SAID AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Massachusetts Port Authority shall annually contribute
- 2 the sum of three hundred thousand dollars to the city of Chelsea
- 3 as reimbursement for loss of tax revenue to said city as a result
- 4 of land takings by said Authority.
