AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 15 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most
3 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 787 of the acts of
4 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—
5 There shall be a board of trustees of the University of Massa-
6 chusetts consisting of the governor, the commissioner of edu-
7 cation, the commissioner of agriculture, the commissioner of
8 public health, the commissioner of mental health, and the
9 president of the college, *ex officio*, two members selected by
10 the faculty of the University of Massachusetts at Boston, two
11 members elected by the faculty of the University of Massachu-
12 setts at Amherst, one member elected by the faculty of the
13 University of Massachusetts Medical School, and not more
14 than seventeen appointive members, none of whom shall be
15 affiliated in any capacity with a private medical school.

1 SECTION 2. Section 4 of chapter 75 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section 1 of chapter 648 of the acts of 1962, is
3 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following sentence:— Ten mem-
5 bers shall be a quorum.
