AN ACT RELATING TO THE LOCATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AT BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 2 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 2A.* Notwithstanding any provision of chapter
- 4 seventy-five of the General Laws to the contrary, the branch
- 5 of the University of Massachusetts established in the city of
- 6 Boston shall remain located within the political limits of
- 7 the city of Boston.

AS SET FORTH IN THE MESSAGE ON THE CONDITION OF THE STATE AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX.

As it is the duty of the Senate and House of Representatives to advise the Governor on the condition of the State, and by the authority of the Senate and House of Representatives:

1. Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 2 the following section:—
2. Section 24. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter 75 of the General Laws to the contrary, the board of the University of Massachusetts established in the city of Boston shall remain located within the political limits of the city of Boston.
