AN ACT RELATIVE TO VACANCIES IN TOWN OFFICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11 of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 3 of chapter 341 of the acts of
3 1938, is hereby further amended by striking out the last sen-
4 tence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—
5 The person so appointed or elected shall be a registered voter
6 of the town and shall perform the duties of the office until
7 the next annual meeting or until another is qualified.
