AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR VEHICLES WHEN APPROACHING PEDESTRIANS ON CERTAIN MARKED CROSSWALKS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section eleven of chapter eighty-nine of the General Laws
- 2 is hereby repealed.
