AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE COLLEGES TO ESTABLISH A COMPULSORY COURSE IN THE PHILOSOPHY AND OBJECTIVES OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The board of trustees of state colleges is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to establish a course equivalent to three semester
- 3 hours in the philosophy and objectives of vocational education
- 4 to be taken by all students at state colleges.
