## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING A TEN THOUSAND DOLLAR SUBSIDY TO MASSACHUSETTS DENTAL SCHOOLS FOR EACH MASSACHUSETTS RESIDENT ENROLLED IN FULL TIME ATTENDANCE DURING THE PRECEDING ACADEMIC YEAR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
2 after section 7E the following section:—

3 *Section 7F.* There are hereby established subsidies in the  
4 amount of ten thousand dollars each payable to dental schools  
5 operating in the commonwealth for each resident of the com-  
6 monwealth enrolled in full time attendance during the preceding  
7 academic year in said dental schools.
