## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

### AN ACT PROVIDING REIMBURSEMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF TEACHERS OF CERTAIN SPECIAL CLASSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 46E of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by section 56 of chapter 14 of the acts of 1966,  
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 The state treasurer shall annually on or before November  
6 twentieth pay to any city, town or regional school district certi-  
7 fied by the commissioner to have paid teachers of classes con-  
8 ducted to meet the requirements of sections forty-six, forty-  
9 six A and forty-six H of this chapter and sections twenty-  
10 eight A, thirty-two and thirty-three of chapter sixty-nine com-  
11 pensation in excess of the regular compensation paid to its  
12 teachers out of the Local Aid Fund, a sum not to exceed five  
13 hundred dollars for each such teacher so paid.
