By Mr. Sisitsky of Springfield, petition of Alan D. Sisitsky that provision be made for scholarship aid for medical and dental students who are residents and who attend schools of medicine or schools of dentistry in the Commonwealth. Education.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING SCHOLARSHIP AID FOR MEDICAL AND DENTAL STUDENTS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND WHO ATTEND SCHOOLS OF MEDICINE OR SCHOOLS OF DENTISTRY IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The chancellor of the board of higher education is authorized
- 2 to distribute, from funds appropriated therefor and under such
- 3 regulation as he may promulgate, scholarship aid to deserving
- 4 and qualified students who are attending schools of medicine
- 5 and schools of dentistry licensed and located in the common-
- 6 wealth.
- 7 The said chancellor shall confer with deans of such medical
- 8 and dental schools as to the cost of tuition, room and board.
- 9 Not more than thirty-five per cent of the available funds for
- 10 such scholarship aid shall be granted to students attending any
- 11 one of such schools.
